- Sruti is a volunteer-run organization. Its leadership comprises of an elected Board of Directors and several committees. Sruti publishes an annual magazine Sruti Ranjani and a periodical, Sruti Notes.
 - Every year, around 10 or more world class music and dance recitals are presented during the Spring and Fall seasons by Sruti in the Greater Philadelphia area including the City, Suburbs and the State of Delaware.
