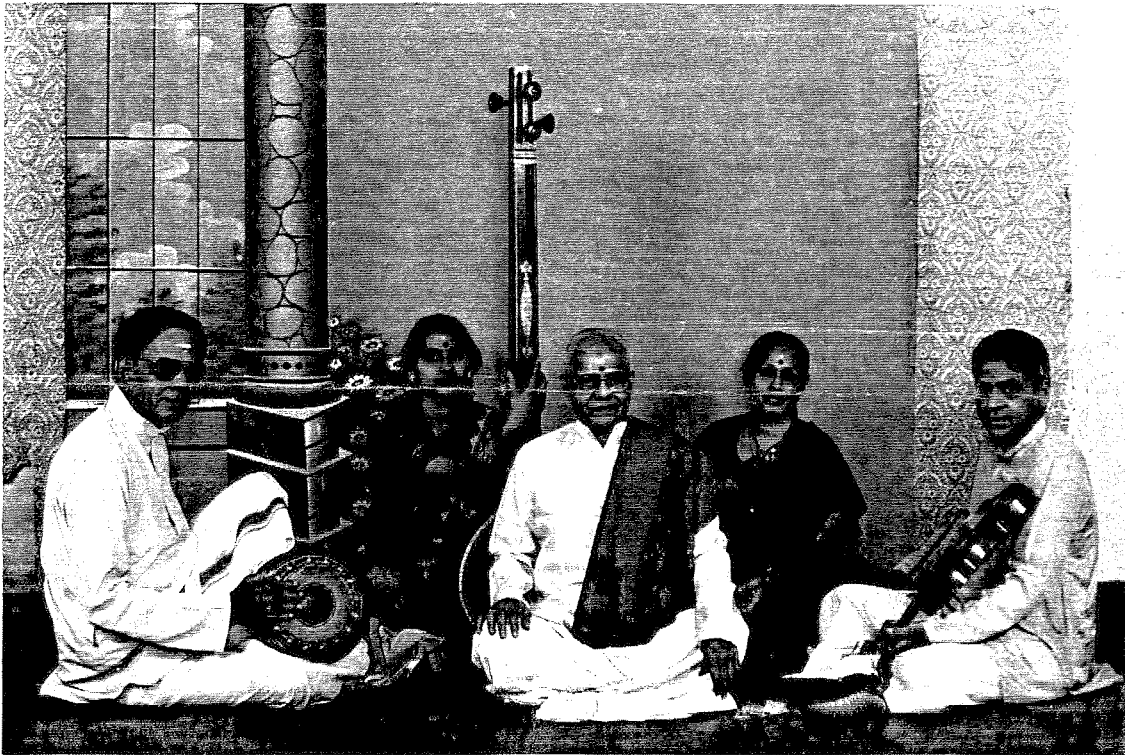

PALAKKAD K. V. NARAYANASWAMY popularly known as KVN, has been in the forefront of Carnatic Music world for decades. The standard bearer of the great Ariyakudi bani, KVN's concerts are well known for the measured balance of alapana, kriti rendition, neraval and swaraprastharam. The clarity of his voice and his legendary Sruti suddham (unison) heighten the enjoyment of his music by the audience.

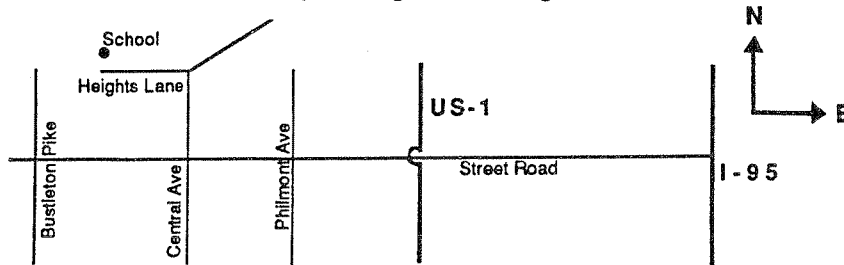
KVN had visited USA a number of times for concert tours as well as visiting professorship at various universities. He has also given concerts at many cities in Europe, Australia, Singapore etc. KVN has been the recipient of numerous awards which include the Padmasri (1977), the Sangeeth Natak Academy Award (1977), and the prestigious Sangita Kalaridhi (1986) by the Madras Music Academy.

The accompanying artists, Vellore Ramabhadran (mrudangam) and Nagai Muralidharan (violin) are familiar to SRUTI supporters.

RAMABHADRAN who accompanied the late Maharajapuram Santhanam in 1989, has over three decades of a distinctive career to look back upon since his remarkable first appearance with the great Madurai Mani Aiyar. He has the capacity to regulate the tone and the temper of his skill to augment the artistry and style of different performers. Ramabhadran was the second recipient (Palakkad Mani Iyer being the first), of the 'Tala Vilas' award by the Sur Singer Samsad of Bombay. Among the many other awards received by him is the Sangeeth Natak Award of 1991.

MURALIDHARAN had performed twice in SRUTI concerts in 1989, accompanying the flute maestro Dr. N. Ramani and subsequently the late Maharajapuram Santhanam. Muralidharan had early training from his mother Komalavalli and later from R. S. Gopalakrishnan. He is now one of the most accomplished young violinists and is one of the most sought after accompanists.

Directions to Poquessing Junior High School:



1. From I-95 take exit for Street Road PA-132 (in Bucks county). Go West on Street Road for nearly five miles. Turn right on Central Ave (This is the fourth traffic light after the intersection of US-1 and Street Road). Follow directions 2.
2. There are three gas stations (SUNOCO, GULF & BP) and a MIDAS Muffler shop at the intersection of Central Ave and Street Road. Central Ave terminates on Heights lane. At this junction turn left on to Heights Lane and you will see the school buildings. The second building on the right is the Junior High School. You can park in the school parking lot around the building.
Address of the school: 300, Heights Lane, Feasterville, PA 19047.
3. Traveling North on US-1 (Roosevelt Blvd) take exit for Street Road (PA-132) West and travel to Central Ave (fourth traffic light after getting on to Street Road). Turn right on Central Ave. Follow directions in 2.
4. From Penna Tpk (I-276) take exit 28, for US-1. Travel South on US-1 for nearly two miles. Take exit for Street Road West and follow directions 3.
5. From NJ Tpk, take exit 6 for Penna Tpk. Follow directions 4.
6. From King of Prussia take Penna Tpk East (I-276 East) and follow directions 4.
