Sanjay Subramanyan has been acclaimed as one of the most serious exponents of Carnatic music of this generation. His initial training started at the age of seven under Sri V. Lakshminarayanan in vocal music as well as violin. He continued learning from Smt. Rukmini Rajagopalan for a period of eight years and finally from Calcutta Sri K.S. Krishnamurthi. Sanjay has given several performances in India and other countries, such as USA, Canada, Malaysia, Singapore, Indonesia, Australia and Oman. He has received the prestigious "Sanskriti Award" from the Sanskriti Foundation, New Delhi, for the category of Performing Art for 1996-97. He has numerous awards and prizes for outstanding performances at the Music Academy and various Sabhas in Chennai, including the award of "Yuva Kala Bharathi" from Bharat Kalachar.

A. Anantha Krishnan belongs to the *shishya parampara* of Muthuswami Dikshitar - one of the Carnatic Music Trinity. His earliest music training was in vocal music and violin from his father, Vainika Vidwan Sri Anantha Rama Iyer. He gave his first solo performance at the age of eleven and has since accompanied top-level musicians, including Dr. T. Vishwanathan, D.K. Pattammal, D.K. Jayaraman, K.V. Narayanaswamy, T.N. Seshagopalan, T.N. Sankaranarayan, Chitravina Ravikiran and Nedunuri Krishnamoorthy. He has performed extensively in India, North America and throughout Europe. He has also learnt Hindustani music from Pandit V.G. Jog. Anantha Krishnan lives in New Jersey and teaches music.

Padmasri Palghat R. Raghu has been endowed with the rich artistic heritage of Tanjore Vaidyanatha Ayyar from the initial training under Tinniam Venkatarama Iyer and later under the percussion wizard Palghat Sri Mani Iyer. He has toured extensively all over the world, including USA, Europe, South East Asia and Australia. He has performed at the Hollywood Bowl along with Ravi Shankar and Alla Rakha in 1965. Among the many titles he has been awarded are Padma Sri by the Government of India in 1984, Sangeetha Nataka Academy award and the Palghat Mani Iyer award in 1983, Mridangam Chakravarthi by the Cleveland University in 1989, Kalai Mamani by the Tamil Nadu Government in 1992, He has trained several students, who are currently at the concert performing level.

Directions to Paxon Hollow Middle School, Broomall, Pa.

- (1) From the Blue Route (I-476) going South, , take exit 4, take the left fork on the ramp, stay in the middle lane and make a left turn onto Rte.3 East (West Chester Pike). Go over the Blue route overpass and turn right at the first traffic light after the overpass onto Lawrence Rd. (Pathmark on your right). Follow directions in (4)
- (2) From the Blue Route (I-476) going North, take exit 4, turn right at the ramp onto Rte. 3 East. At the first traffic light turn right onto Lawrence Rd. (Pathmark on your right.) Follow directions in (4)
- (3) From Philadelphia, Upper Darby areas, take Rte. 3 West to Lawrence Road (after Manoa shopping center and just before the Blue route - Haverford Mercy Hospital on your left). Turn left onto Lawrence Rd. Follow direction in (4)
- (4) Lawrence Rd. ends on Rte. 320 (Sproul Rd). (Rickel's on your left). Make a right turn on to Sproul Rd., get to the left lane and turn left at the first traffic light onto Paxon Hollow Rd. The middle school is about half a mile on your left.
- (5) Traveling East on West Chester Pike (Rte. 3 East), turn right onto Rte. 320 South. Travel about 2 miles to Paxon Hollow Rd. (Commerce Bank on your right). Turn right onto Paxon Hollow Rd. The middle school is about half a mile on your left.
- (6) Traveling North on Rte. 320 about 2 miles after intersection with Rte 1, go past Kmart and Lawrence Park shopping center on your right, get to the left lane, turn left onto Paxon Hollow Rd. (Commerce Bank just ahead of you on the left). The middle school is about half a mile on your left.
