She has been performing in all the reputed institutions and festivals in India, earning the critical acclaim of critics and rasikas. An 'A' Grade artiste of The All India Radio, she is the recipient of many awards from institutions like the Shanmukhananda Sabha, the Music Academy, Krishna Gana Sabha, as well as the title of 'Yuva Kala Bharathi.'

Additionally, she is a commerce graduate of Bombay University, and a recipient of a Diploma in music from the Gandharva Maha Vidyalyaya.

A leading young violinist, he has been under the tutelage of Padmasri Lalgudi G. Jayaraman since 1987. He also received training from Sri. Hosahalli Venkatram and Smt. T. Rukmani. Prominent young artists like Bombay Jayashri, Soumya, Neyveli Santhanagopalan, Unnikrishnan, and Sanjay Subramaniam single out Vittal Ramamurthy's accompaniment as being among the best. He has performed for all the leading sabhas in India and has toured widely in Southeast Asian countries, accompanying Sudha Raghunathan, T.V. Sankaranarayanan, and Nedunuri Krishnamurthy, in addition to giving solo concerts.

He has received many awards, a few of which are: 'Best Accompanist' from Sri Krishna Gana Sabha in 1987 and from the Musci Academy in '90, '91, and '93. He is an 'A' Grade artiste of The All India Radio, and Doordarshan.

A performing artiste and teacher of mridangam, he hails from a family of prominent musicians, including his sister Palani Vijayalakshmi. His initial training was with Sri Palghat Mahadeva Iyer and advanced instruction with Sri Kumbakonam Rajappa Iyer. Since 1960, he has accompanied such stalwarts as Lalgudi G. Jayaraman, K.V. Narayanaswamy, S. Balachander, Dr. N. Ramani, Dr. Balamuralikrishna, and T.N. Seshagopalan, just to name some. During 1975, he accompanied veena S. Balachander on a cultural exchange program, which took them all over Europe.

In 1959, he received the Dr. Henry Powell prize for the best junior artiste in mridungam from the Madras Music Academy. In 1961 he was judged the Best Artiste in Mridangam in an All India Radio competition. He has been endowed with many other such awards from music organizations for his mridungam playing. A graded artiste of The All India Radio and Doordarshan, he trains students in mridangam performance in Bombay.

- From Ben Franklin Bridge take I-676 to I-76 West (schulkyll Expway). Follow 3.
- From Walt Witman Bridge follow I-76 West (Schulkyll Expway). Follow 3.
- From I-76 (Schulkyll Expway) exit on to I-476 North (towards Plymouth Meeting). Follow 5.
- From Delaware take I-95 North to exit 7 onto I-476 North (towards Plymouth Meeting). Follow 5.
- On I-476, Get off at exit-9, towards Germantown Pike West. Follow 7.
- Go west on Germantown Pike to Route 202. Turn right on to Route 202 North. Cross Route 73 and go past the first sign for Montgomery Community College and at the next light (Morris Road) make a right. Make a right into the college (there is a sign here too). Parking is on your left.
- From Pennsylvania Turnpike, take Exit 25 at Norristown. Follow signs for Plymouth Road, left at first light and right at next light. You will be now on Germantown Pike West. Follow 7.
- From King of Prussia. Take Route 202 North past the Mall and through Norristown. Continue on Route 202 going past shopping center at Germantown Pike (Hechinger on your left). Stay on Route 202 following appropriate directions in 7.
