Krishnam Vande Jagatgurum - a dance drama on Lord Kirshna, produced by the International Dance Alliance, Madras, depicts episodes from the life of Krishna. It weaves into them the verses of the ancient Krishna Ashtakam sloka (hymn) — a compilation of eight couplets extolling the beauty and virtues of Krishna based on Jayadeva's Geetha Govindam.

Dr. Sudharani Raghupathy, the choreographer, is a well known exponent of Bharatanatyam. She also studied modern dance at the Randolph Macon Women's college in Virginia. She has also choreographed several group productions such as the Hindu epic Ramayana and Rabindranath Tagore's Gitanjali.

Directions to Plymouth Whitemarsh High School.
