About the Artists

Pavithra Prasad started learning Bharatanatyam from her school days under the tutelage of Guru Natyacharya Aravind and Ms. Radha. She gave her Arangetram in 1985 and since then she has given numerous performances sponsored by well known sabhas and institutions like Sangeet Natak Academy, Eyal Isai Nataka Mandram etc. Awards and titles conferred on Pavithra Prasad include "Yuva Kala Bharathi" by Bharath Kalachar, "Best Talented Young Danseuse" by Madras Music Academy and Smt. Balasaraswati trust award for "Best Danseuse" by Sri Krishna Gana Sabha. Pavithra was one of the dancers in the IDA performance of "Krishnam vande Jagadgurum".

Sri Seetha Rama Sarma hails from Kuchipudi village in Andhra Pradesh - a birth place of musical tradition and Kuchipudi dance form. He is a musician of high rank in classical music and an approved composer of AIR, Madras for both light and classical music. Directions to Radnor High School:

- 1. From I-276 (Penna Tumpike) or I-76 (Schuylkill Expwy.) take I-476 (Blue Route) South. Follow directions in 5.
- 2. From Ben Franklin Bridge take I-676 (Vine St. Expwy.) West to I-76 West to I-476 (Blue Route) South. Follow directions in 5.
- 3. From Walt Whitman Bridge take I-95 South past Phila Airport to I-476 (Blue Route) North. Follow directions in 6.
- 4. From Delaware take I-95 North to I-476 (Blue Route) North. Follow directions in 6.
- 5. From I-476 (Blue Route) South take exit 5. Turn right at the end of the ramp onto Rte. 30 East. Immediately get onto the left lane and turn left at the traffic light onto King of Prussia Road. Follow 9.
- 6. From I-476 (Blue Route) North take exit 5. Stay on the middle lane, cross Rte. 30 onto King of Prussia Road. Follow 9
- 7. From Rte. 30 West past Villanova University, turn right onto King of Prussia Road. Follow 9.
- 8. From Rte. 30 East past Devon, turn left onto King of Prussia Road. Follow 9.
- 9. On King of Prussia Road within few yards, you will see the school on left.
