

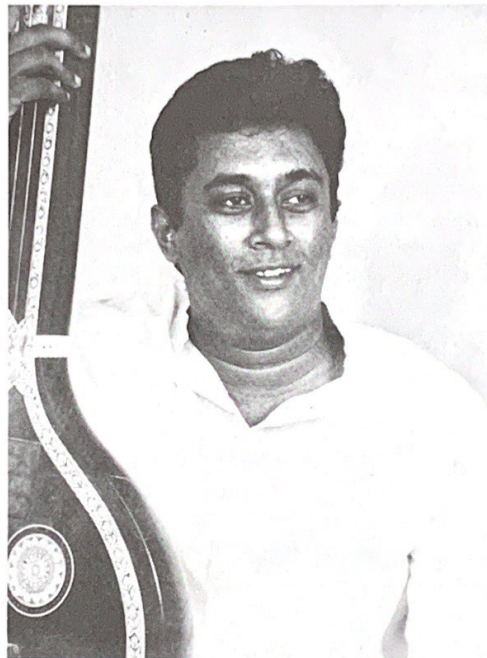

Sri Sanjay Subrahmanyan:

He is a widely acclaimed young vocalist and has won the praise of connoisseurs of Carnatic music for his chaste, imaginative, and expressive style. He underwent training initially in violin playing from Sr. V. Lakshminarayana. His vocal training was from his grand-aunt Smt. Rukmini Rajagopalan, followed up with advanced instruction by Vidwan Calcutta K.S. Krishnamoorthy. His concert performances have taken place at all the prestigious sabhas of music organizations all over India, like the Madras Music Academy, Krishna Gana Sabha, Indian Fine Arts Society, SPIC-MACAY, etc. Among the innumerable honors he has been accorded are the Music Academy's Outstanding Junior Musician Award and the title of '*Yuva Kala Bharati*' from Bharat Kalachar.

Sri R.K. Sreeramkumar:

A very popular violinist, he had his initial training from his grandfather, the late Sri. Venkatarama Sastry. He is currently undergoing advanced training with Sri. V.V.Subramaniam. Sreeramkumar is very much in demand as an accompanist, having accompanied stalwarts such as Semmangudi Srinivasa Iyer, M.S.Subbalakshmi, D.K.Pattammal, D.K.Jayaraman, K.V.Narayanaswamy and N.Ramani. He is a recipient of the title '*Yuva Kala Bharati*' from Bharat Kalachar.

Sri K. Arun Prakash:

He commenced his mridangam training under Sri. Ramanathapuram M.N. Kandaswamy at the age of nine. He is the son of the famous music composer Sri. L. Krishnan, a disciple of GNB. His concert repertory is wide and rich, having accompanied stalwarts like K.V.Narayanaswamy, D.K.Jayaraman, T.N.Seshagopalan, U.Srinivas, and Ravi Kiran. The recipient of the *Best Mridangist Award* from the Madras Music Academy in 1994, he has also sever all other accolades to his credit.

Directions to Poquessing Middle School, Feasterville, PA:

1. From I-95, take exit for street Road PA-132 (in Bucks County). Go West on Street Road for nearly 5 miles. Turn right on Central Avenue (This is the fourth traffic light after the intersection of US-1 and Street Road). Follow directions in 2.
2. There are three gas stations (SUNOCO, GULF, and BP) and a Midas Muffler shop at the intersection of Central Avenue and Street Road. Central Avenue ends on Heights Lane. At this junction, turn left onto Heights Lane and the second building on the right is the School. Parking allowed anywhere around the building.
3. Traveling North on US-1 (Roosevelt Blvd.) take exit for Street Road (PA-132) West and travel to Central Avenue (4th Traffic light after getting onto Street Road). Turn right onto Central Avenue. Follow directions in 2.
4. From Penna Turnpike (I-276) take exit 28, US-1. Travel South on US-1 and take exit for Street Road West and follow directions in 3.
5. From NJ Turnpike, take exit 6 for Penna Turnpike. Follow directions in 4.
6. From King of Prussia, take Penna Turnpike (I-276 East) and follow directions in 4.

P.S. Use Rear entrance of School if front entrance is closed
