

Sankari Krishnan M.A. M.Phil (Music), a gold medalist from the University of Madras was initiated into music at a very tender age by Shri K.S.Subramanian of Trichy. His encouragement had fired a passion in Sankari to pursue music as a career. While doing her post graduation in Music in Chennai, she had the good fortune of becoming a disciple of one of the greatest maestros of all times— Padmabhushan Lalgudi Shri G.Jayaraman. This privilege continued uninterrupted for more than twenty years until the great Guru left his mortal coils. She has been fortunate to absorb his music and become a responsible torch bearer of his bani.

Charulatha Ramanujam - Violin

Charulatha is one of the leading violinists from Bangalore and a most 'sought after' accompanist now. Born in a family steeped in classical music, Charulatha was initiated into music (1978) by her late father K. Rangaswamy, a vocalist of merit. With her mother's support, Charulatha proved to be a meticulous student of Vidwan Pudukottai R Ramanathan, a direct disciple of the legend – Vidwan Kumbakonam Rajamanickam Pillai. She later learnt from the Late Vidwan Anoor S Ramakrishna of Bangalore. Charulatha's violin pedigree received further polish with guidance from, Sangita Kalanidhi Late Vidwan RK Srikantan. Presently, Charulatha is getting advanced training from octogenarian Vidushi Smt Neela Ramgopal of Bangalore .

V. S. Raghavan - Mridangam

Sri. V.S. Raghavan is a performer, composer, educator, researcher, and entrepreneur. He is considered a top-class mridangam player, and musical ambassador, and has accompanied legends of Indian Classical music.

He received his initial mridangam training from the late Kumbakonam Rajappa iyer, and advanced training from maestro, Sri. Patri Satish Kumar, in Chennai, India. Starting at the age of nine, he has performed more than 1600 concerts as a distinguished soloist as well as collaborator in diverse music and dance ensembles.
