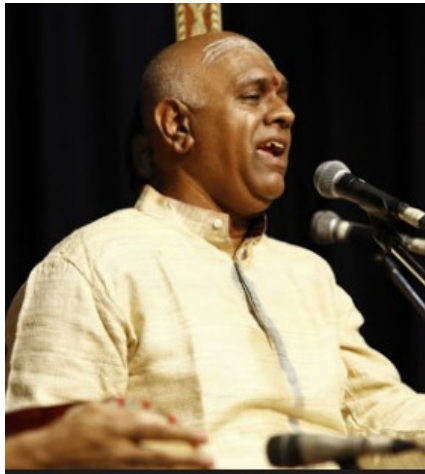

## **Vijay Siva**

Vijay Siva is an eminent Carnatic vocalist with traditional roots. He had initial training in vocal music from his mother Smt Akhila Siva. Vijay Siva is a gold medalist from Carnatic Music College, Chennai. He came under the tutelage of Sangeetha Kalanidhi Sri D.K. Jayaraman and received guidance from Smt. D.K. Pattammal. Vijay Siva has performed widely in India, US and is the recipient of several awards including "Isai Peroli" (1995). Vijay Siva is also an accomplished mridangist.

## **R.K. Shriramkumar**

R.K. Shriramkumar is a leading Carnatic violinist and belongs to the Rudrapatnam family, known for glorious Carnatic musical tradition. Having had his initial training in violin from Smt. Savitri Satyamurthy, Shriramkumar was trained by his grandfather R.K. Venkatarama Shastri. He later received guidance from Shri V.V. Subrahmanyam and also had training in vocal music from Sangita Kalanidhi Sri D.K. Jayaraman. Shriramkumar has received several awards and has widely performed in concerts and music festivals around the world, accompanying leading artists.

## **J. Vaidyanathan**

J.Vaidhyathan is a well-known mridangist and the son of Sangeetha Kalanidhi Sri D.K. Jayaraman. He is the disciple of Sangeetha Kalanidhi Dr T.K. Murthy and has won several awards and titles in his 40 year career including 'Kalai Mamani' (2006) and 'Isai Peroli' (2010) and the Sangeeth Natak Academy Puraskar award (2018).
